2012-21	Town of Webb - A multi-modal transportation facility involving wetlands which connects to the ending point of the existing TOBIE Trail (Phase 1) on Railroad Avenue in Old Forge to the Thendara Train Station. (TOBIE = Thendara, Old Forge, Big Moose, Inlet and Eagle Bay.) A pedestrian bridge (requiring a variance) spanning the Middle Branch of the Moose River will need to be constructed in order to accomplish the connection. This project includes five segments in two areas of the Town of Webb, addressing significant portions of an important gap of the 14 mile town-wide trail and transportation corridor linking five hamlets. The project includes two segments. The paved trail will generally consist of signed bicycle and pedestrian facilities throughout the project corridor and a shared-use trail for sections located within the old railroad right-of-way. The bridge portion of this project includes the erection of a pre-fabricated pedestrian truss bridge superstructure on the existing stone masonry abutments from a former railroad crossing.
