2012-128	Essex County, NY State Police and NYSEG – Emergency Telecommunications System – Installation of telecommunications equipment at 14 locations within the Park as part of a Public Safety Radio System & Shared Microwave Network. The microwave network will be utilized by Essex County, the New York State Police, and New York State Electric and Gas. The proposal seeks to remove 36 existing antennas at sites located throughout the Park and install 57 new antennas (net increase of 21 antennas within the Park). The proposal also involves the installation of a microwave panel reflector at a presently undeveloped site at TMD 47.2-1-63.110, the replacement of a 185± foot tall tower with a new tower in the immediate vicinity at TMD 86.3-1-10), the replacement and expansion of ski patrol building at TMD 25-1-15, and the extension of the height of existing towers at TMDs 37-2-44.1, and 521-1-2. Other than the microwave panel reflector site all infrastructure is proposed at to be co-located on existing buildings or other existing telecommunications infrastructure. In addition to the above, de minimis activities at two in-Park sites (Whiteface Summit and Blue Mountain Summit) were determined to not require an Agency permit. The system also includes two out-of-Park sites, one site is located on Grandpa's Knob, VT and the other site is located in Plattsburgh, NY.	Application received 7/26/2012. NIPA issued on 8/31/2012.
