



**Notice of Public Hearing
for
Adirondack Park Agency
2009 State Land Classification Proposals**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that five public hearings will be held by the Adirondack Park Agency pursuant to Section 816 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act to classify or reclassify certain State lands within the Adirondack Park. The action involves 91 State land classification proposals totaling approximately 31,056 acres and four (4) State land reclassification proposals totaling an estimated 468 acres. Total acreage involved in the action is approximately 31,524 acres. The classification proposals involve lands in ten (10) counties including: Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Hamilton, Herkimer, Lewis, Oneida, St. Lawrence, and Warren.

The proposed action involves only the classification or reclassification of State lands according to the provisions of the Adirondack Park State Land Master Plan. This action does not authorize the development of new structures or improvements without prior SEQRA assessment by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation and/or the Adirondack Park Agency.
