SUMMARY AND AUTHORIZATION

Essex County is granted a permit, and the New York State Police (NYSP) is granted an order on conditions pursuant to Sections 810 and 814 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act, authorizing the installation of infrastructure associated with the comprehensive emergency communication system approved by Agency Project Order and Findings 2012-128.

The infrastructure approved herein is located in a Resource Management land use area, on the summit of Mount Defiance, in the Town of Ticonderoga, Essex County. The project site is identified on Town of Ticonderoga Tax Map Section 151.3, Block 1 as Parcel 1.

The project as proposed and authorized is summarized as:

Infrastructure owned, used and maintained by Essex County include:

1. One (1) 19.8 foot long land mobile radio (LMR) receiver whip antenna to be mounted on the roof of the building with the tip elevation of 39.8± feet above ground level (AGL);
2. One (1) 60 inch LMR Corner reflector transmitter wall mounted at a tip elevation of 12.0± feet AGL;
3. One (1) 12.0 foot long paging whip antenna wall mounted at a tip elevation of 20± feet AGL; and
4. One (1) six foot long Essex County LMR communications dipole antenna with reflector wall mounted at a tip elevation of 12± feet AGL.

Infrastructure which will be owned by the NYSP and used by Essex County, NYSEG, and the NYSP include:

1. One (1) six-foot microwave dish antenna with radome to be installed on a pipe mount at a centerline elevation of 18± feet AGL; and
2. One (1) six-foot microwave dish antenna with radome to be installed on a new wall stabilized lattice structure at a centerline of 26± feet AGL.

The project involves the replacement of an existing backup generator and fuel storage with a new propane generator and fuel storage tanks; this infrastructure will be owned by Essex County.

CONDITIONS

Conditions in Order and Findings 2012-128

1. All conditions in Order and Findings 2012-128 remain in full force and effect.

Additional Conditions Specific to this Project Site

2. The project shall be undertaken as described in the completed application, the Project Description as Proposed and Conditions herein. In the case of conflict, the Conditions control. Failure to comply with the permit is a violation and may subject the applicant, successors and assigns to civil penalties and other legal proceedings, including modification, suspension or revocation of the permit.
3. All deeds conveying all or a portion of the lands subject to this permit shall contain the following reference: "The lands conveyed are subject to Adirondack Park Agency Project Order and Findings 2012-128 issued December 18, 2012 and Permit 2012-128-11 issued December 18, 2012 the terms and conditions of which are binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the grantors and all subsequent grantees."
4. The antenna infrastructure (including but not limited to the microwave dishes, radomes and supporting infrastructure) shall be a non-reflective light grey.
5. In accordance with Condition 12 of the Project Order and Findings, the photolocation for documenting the construction of the infrastructure approved herein shall be from the summit of Mount Defiance.
