DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Timber harvesting on a 549 acre portion of Lyme's 16,159 acre Colton-Piercefield tract, jurisdictional under the Agency's timber harvesting regulations. Seven discrete silvicultural prescriptions are proposed across the harvest area, based upon stand conditions and desired outcomes.
