DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: The project is briefly described as the application of the pesticide Prenfish (Active Ingredient: 5% Rotenone) to remove non-native largemouth bass (first documented in 2007) from Bay Pond. The lake will be stocked to establish a native brook trout population upon natural degradation of the toxicant. This will be the third reclamation of Bay Pond with previous reclamations having been undertaken in 1968, and 1989; the 1989 reclamation was approved by Agency Permit 89-90
