5. <u>Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled</u>:

Five enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **November and December 2016** as follows:

E2016-0156, Woods (Fine, St. Lawrence County) Subdivision in a Resource Management land use area in 2001. Settlement recognizes lot as lawful and conditions that no more than one principal building will be located on the property. Settlement requires a permit for further subdivision of or construction of a principal building on the property. Settlement requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.

• E2015-0150, Holly (Greig, Lewis County)

Construction of a single family dwelling and related development in noncompliance with the requirements of Permit 2001-80. Settlement requires implementation of Agency-approved Stormwater Pollution Prevention and planting plans, payment of a \$2,000 civil penalty, and filing in the County Clerk's Office.

• E2016-0117, O'Rourke (Bolton, Warren County)

Subdivision involving wetlands in 2015. Settlement recognizes property as lawful and allows for proposed 2-lot subdivision of the property. Settlement places requirements on construction of a future single family dwelling and on-site wastewater treatment system and must be filed in the County Clerk's Office.

• E2016-0129, Reale (Ticonderoga, Essex County)

Construction of a single family dwelling on Resource Management lands in 2000. Settlement recognizes dwelling as lawful, restricts lighting and vegetation removal on the property, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.

• E2016-0121, Salls (Ticonderoga, Essex County)

Construction of a single family dwelling on Resource Management lands in 2001. Settlement recognizes dwelling as lawful, restricts lighting and vegetation removal on the property, allows for construction of an accessory garage, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.
