
Thank you for your letter, received by the Agency on October 21, 2019. In this letter you stated that your clients cannot consent to the terms of the proposed settlement agreement forwarded to them on August 21, 2019 regarding an alleged shoreline structure setback violation on tax map parcel 130.18-1-17.110 in the Town of Wells, Hamilton County.

Accordingly, this matter will be referred to the Agency's Enforcement Committee and is tentatively scheduled for the Adirondack Park Agency's February 13-14, 2020 meeting. Agency staff will forward you a Notice of Apparent Violation and supporting documents prior to this date. Once the Notice of Apparent Violation is served, you will have 30 days to respond if you choose to do so. Please note that any statements made before the Committee must be based only on the record consisting of the Notice of Apparent Violation and supporting documents and any responses.

Please note that the proceeding brought by staff will seek a decision on an appropriate disposition, including payment of a civil penalty as provided for in Executive Law § 813(1). Agency staff remain open to settlement of this alleged violation at any time prior to the February Agency meeting.
