RE: Planning Division Activity Report for January through March 2022

This report reflects monthly activity for the Planning Division staff.

APSLMP CONSULTATIONS

UMP Development/Review

- Jessup River Wild Forest (In development) The amendment proposes to construct the Piseco Tannery Historical Trail (a 0.4±-mile trail). The trail will be built to accessible standards using trenched stone and boardwalk construction methods and will offer multiple viewpoints of the historic ruins associated with former tannery operations.
- Alger Island Campground Intensive Use Area (In development) The amendment addresses shoreline stabilization management including the replacement of boarding/mooring decks with dock structures.
- Sharp Bridge Campground Intensive Use Area (*In development*) This new UMP proposes the reconstruction of a caretaker cabin and roads, replacement of dumping station, rehabilitation of the campground's water system, and restoration of campsites.
- Whiteface Mountain Intensive Use Area (Out for public comment) This amendment entails upgrading facilities in advance of the 2023 World University Games, including homologation of trails; widening of existing trails; identification of future mountain biking and hiking trails to be built in accordance with forthcoming trail guidance from the DEC and APA; additional restroom facilities; EV charging stations; and a new lift to the Legacy Lodge.
- Generic UMP for Campgrounds and Day Use Areas (Out for public comment) This
 amendment allows for the permanent construction of watercraft decontamination
 facilities to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species associated with recreational
 boating.
- Rollins Pond Campground (In development) This new UMP complements the recently completed Fish Creek Campground UMP and includes management actions to improve and upgrade the facilities as well as a reclassification action.

APA/DEC MOU Consultation

- Reviewed State Land Project consisting of trail work plan for bog bridge submitted by DEC Region 5 staff for the Silver Lake Wilderness.
- Consulted with Region 6 DEC staff regarding potential construction of new road bridge in the Independence River Wild Forest.
- Consulted with DEC Central Office staff regarding potential construction of new docks at the Alger Island Campground.
- Consulted with DEC Central Office staff regarding maintenance of existing shoreline structures at the Alger Island Campground.
- Consulted with Region 5 DEC staff regarding use of motor vehicles and heavy machinery for construction access pertaining to the Cedar River bridge in the Essex Chain Lake Primitive Area.
- Consulted with Region 5 DEC staff regarding beaver dam removal in the Essex Chain Lake Primitive Area.
- Reviewed State Land Project regarding potential construction of trail bridge submitted by Region 5 DEC staff for the Vanderwhacker Mountain Wild Forest.
- Consulted with Region 5 DEC staff regarding design alternatives for a causeway associated with the Remsen to Lake Placid Travel Corridor.
- Reviewed State Land Project regarding potential re-construction of a bridge submitted by DEC Region 5 staff for the West Canada Lakes Wilderness.
- Reviewed State Land Project consisting of potential new bridge construction submitted by DEC Region 5 staff for the Lake George Wild Forest.
- Consulted with Region 5 DEC staff regarding potential construction of footbridges in the Moose River Plains Wild Forest.

PARK POLICY AND PLANNING

- Continued a planning effort with DEC to develop Park-wide guidance on an approach to "Visitor Use Management" on State lands, which may be used for future UMP proposals to address visitor-use impacts. As part of this, participated in conference calls and meetings with DEC staff.
- Provide co-leadership in the State's ongoing Trail Stewardship Working Group, whose charge is to examine and revise certain policies and guidance related to trail construction in the Forest Preserve to ensure their consistency with Article XIV of the New York State Constitution and conformance with the State Land Master Plan.
- Represented the Agency on the NYS Road Salt Reduction Task Force and worked with training and outreach as well as road salt impacts subcommittees to make recommendations for inclusion in the Task Force's report to the legislature.
- Coordinated Agency staff to review pertinent chapters of the Climate Action Council's Draft Scoping Plan and prepare informal comments to the co-chair agencies for the June 10, 2022 deadline.
