For information: The moose population in New York has increased since natural recolonization of the state but is potentially stagnating and contends with multiple limiting factors. Ongoing monitoring and field investigations on the potential mechanisms limiting moose indicate parasite-induced disease is an important consideration for moose conservation in the state. Here we present information on the status of moose in NY and the impacts of parasites on moose population health.
