SUMMARY AND AUTHORIZATION

This permit authorizes a multiple family dwelling in an area classified Resource Management on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map in the Town of Putnam, Washington County.

This authorization shall expire unless recorded in the Washington County Clerk's Office within 60 days of issuance of a signed and notarized permit. The signed and notarized permit shall be recorded in the names of all persons listed above and in the names of all owners of record of any portion of the project site on the recordation date.

The project shall not be undertaken or continued unless the project authorized herein is in existence within five years of the date the permit is recorded in the County Clerk's Office. The Agency will consider the project in existence when the foundation for the apartment authorized herein has been constructed.

The project shall be undertaken in compliance with all conditions stated herein. Failure to comply with this permit is a violation and may subject the permittee, successors, and assigns to civil penalties and other legal proceedings.

This permit does not convey any right to trespass upon the lands or interfere with the riparian rights of others in order to undertake the authorized project, nor does it authorize the impairment of any easement, right, title or interest in real or personal property.

Nothing contained in this permit shall be construed to satisfy any legal obligations of the permittee to comply with all applicable laws and regulations or to obtain any governmental approval or permit from any entity other than the Agency, whether federal, State, regional, or local.

PROJECT SITE

The project site is a 51.4±-acre parcel of land located on County Route 3 in the Town of Putnam, Washington County, in an area classified Resource Management on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map. The site is identified as Tax Map Section 13, Block 2, Parcel 20, and is described in a deed from Richard L. Wilson and Darrell Thomas Wilson to Darrell Thomas Wilson and Jeanene M. Wilson, dated August 28, 2014, and recorded March 25, 2015 in the Washington County Clerk's Office under Instrument Number 2015-00097372.

The project site is improved by a pre-existing single family dwelling, an individual water supply well, an on-site wastewater treatment system, attached garage, and a barn.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project as conditionally approved herein involves construction of an apartment attached to the existing single family dwelling and the installation of an on-site wastewater treatment system and an individual water supply well to serve the apartment.

The project is shown on a 10-sheet set of Project Plans titled "Darrell Wilson Residence, Home Apartment Addition," prepared by Trudeau Engineering, and last revised on July 26, 2022. A reduced-scale copy of Sheet 4 of the Project Plans is attached as a part of this permit for reference.

AGENCY JURISDICTION

Pursuant to Section 809(2)(a) of the Adirondack Park Agency Act, a permit is required from the Adirondack Park Agency prior to the construction of a multiple family dwelling on Resource Management lands in the Adirondack Park.

CONDITIONS

THE PROJECT IS APPROVED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. The project shall not be undertaken until this permit has been recorded in the Washington County Clerk's Office.
2. This permit is binding on the permittee, all present and future owners or lessees of the project site, and all persons undertaking all or a portion of the project. Copies of this permit and the Project Plans shall be furnished by the permittee to all subsequent owners or lessees of the project site prior to sale or lease, and by the permittee and/or any subsequent owner or lessee to all persons undertaking any development activities authorized herein.
3. In addition to complying with all terms and conditions of this permit, all future activities on the project site shall be undertaken in compliance with the requirements of New York State's Adirondack Park Agency Act, Freshwater Wetlands Act, and the Adirondack Park Agency's implementing regulations [9 NYCRR §§ 570-588].

4. All deeds conveying all or a portion of the lands subject to this permit shall contain references to this permit as follows: "The lands conveyed are subject to Adirondack Park Agency Permit 2022-0254, issued January 5, 2023, the conditions of which are binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the grantors and all subsequent grantees."
5. Subject to the conditions stated herein, this permit authorizes the construction of a multiple family dwelling in the location and footprint shown and as described on the Project Plans. Any increase in occupancy or change to the location, dimensions, or other aspect of the multiple-family dwelling shall require prior written Agency authorization.
6. The undertaking of any new land use or development within 300 feet of the right of way of NYS Route 22 shall require a new or amended permit.
7. Any on-site wastewater treatment system on the project site installed within five years of the date of issuance of this permit shall be constructed in conformance with the location and design shown on the Project Plans. Construction of the system shall be supervised by a New York State design professional (licensed engineer or registered architect). Within 30 days of complete system installation and prior to its utilization, the design professional shall provide written certification to the Agency that the system was built in compliance with the approved plans.

No on-site wastewater treatment system shall be installed on the project site more than five years after the date of issuance of this permit except pursuant to written authorization from the Agency.
8. Erosion and sediment controls shall be undertaken as shown and described on the Project Plans.
9. When brought from off-site, all equipment, including but not limited to trucks, excavators, tractors, etc., and hand excavation tools such as shovels, rakes, and picks, to be used on the project site shall be clean and free of soil, mud, or other similar material. If washed on the project site, equipment shall be washed in one location to prevent the distribution of propagules among different wash sites.
10. Any new free-standing or building-mounted outdoor lights associated with the multiple family dwelling on the project site shall employ full cut-off fixtures that are fully shielded to direct light downward and not into the sky or toward County Route 3 or adjoining property.
11. There shall be no more than two principal buildings located on the project site at any time. The multiple family dwelling authorized herein constitutes two principal buildings.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Agency has considered all statutory and regulatory criteria for project approval set forth in the Adirondack Park Agency Act and 9 NYCRR Part 574. The Agency hereby finds that the project authorized as conditioned herein:

- a. will be consistent with the land use and development plan;
- b. will be compatible with the character description and purposes, policies, and objectives of the Resource Management land use area;
- c. will be consistent with the overall intensity guidelines for the Resource Management land use area;
- d. will comply with the shoreline restrictions of § 806 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act; and
- e. will not have an undue adverse impact upon the natural, scenic, aesthetic, ecological, wildlife, historic, recreational or open space resources of the Park or upon the ability of the public to provide supporting facilities and services made necessary by the project.

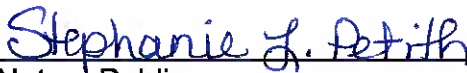
