**SUMMARY AND AUTHORIZATION**

This permit authorizes a two-lot subdivision in an area classified Hamlet on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map in the Village of Mayfield, Fulton County.

This authorization shall expire unless recorded in the Fulton County Clerk's Office within 60 days of issuance of a signed and notarized permit. The signed and notarized permit shall be recorded in the names of all persons listed above and in the names of all owners of record of any portion of the project site on the recordation date.

The project shall not be undertaken or continued unless the project authorized herein is in existence within five years of the date the permit is recorded in the Fulton County Clerk's Office. The Agency will consider the project in existence when an authorized lot has been conveyed to an outside party.

The project shall be undertaken in compliance with all conditions stated herein. Failure to comply with this permit is a violation and may subject the permittee, successors, and assigns to civil penalties and other legal proceedings.

This permit does not convey any right to trespass upon the lands or interfere with the riparian rights of others in order to undertake the authorized project, nor does it authorize the impairment of any easement, right, title or interest in real or personal property.

Nothing contained in this permit shall be construed to satisfy any legal obligations of the permittee to comply with all applicable laws and regulations or to obtain any governmental approval or permit from any entity other than the Agency, whether federal, State, regional, or local.

### **PROJECT SITE**

The project site is an 8.285-acre parcel of land located on Birch Lane in the Village of Mayfield, Fulton County, in an area classified Hamlet on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map. The site is identified as Tax Map Section 104.13, Block 11, Parcel 2, and is described in a deed from Russell Ruliffson to Thomas R. Ruliffson and Martha D. Ruliffson, dated April 4, 1974, and recorded April 29, 1974 in the Fulton County Clerk's Office at Book 530, Page 101.

The project site contains wetlands along the western property line and southwestern corner. Additional wetlands not described herein or depicted on the Site Plan may be located on or adjacent to the project site.

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The project as conditionally approved herein involves a two-lot subdivision of Tax Parcel 104.13-11-2 creating:

- A 7.54 acre parcel improved by a circa 2008 single family dwelling with related development (Lot 1), and
- A 0.745 acre parcel improved by a circa 1900 single family dwelling with related development (Lot 2).

Both dwellings are served by municipal wastewater and municipal water supply and accessed by an existing driveway from Second Avenue.

The project is shown on an un-dated, un-signed, annotated portion of a survey map received by the Agency on April 9, 2026 (Site Plan). A reduced-scale copy of the Site Plan for the project is attached as a part of this permit for reference.

### **AGENCY JURISDICTION**

Pursuant to Section 809(2)(a) of the Adirondack Park Agency Act and Adirondack Park Agency regulations at 9 NYCRR Part 578, a permit is required from the Adirondack Park Agency prior to any subdivision involving wetlands in the Adirondack Park.

### **CONDITIONS**

#### **THE PROJECT IS APPROVED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

1. The project shall not be undertaken until this permit has been recorded in the Fulton County Clerk's Office.
2. This permit is binding on the permittee, all present and future owners or lessees of the project site, and all persons undertaking all or a portion of the project. Copies of this permit and Site Plan shall be furnished by the permittee to all subsequent owners or lessees of the project site prior to sale or lease, and by the permittee and/or any subsequent owner or lessee to all persons undertaking any development activities authorized herein.

3. In addition to complying with all terms and conditions of this permit, all future activities on the project site shall be undertaken in compliance with the requirements of New York State's Adirondack Park Agency Act, Freshwater Wetlands Act, and the Adirondack Park Agency's implementing regulations [9 NYCRR §§ 570-588].
4. All deeds conveying all or a portion of the lands subject to this permit shall contain references to this permit as follows: "The lands conveyed are subject to Adirondack Park Agency Permit 2025-0280, issued April 28, 2026, the conditions of which are binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the grantors and all subsequent grantees."
5. Subject to the conditions stated herein, this permit authorizes a two-lot subdivision as depicted on the Site Plan. Any subdivision not depicted on the Site Plan shall require prior written Agency authorization.
6. Any deed of conveyance for Lot 2 as depicted on the Site Plan shall contain an easement providing access to Lot 1 over the existing driveway as shown and described on the Site Plan.
7. The undertaking of any activity involving wetlands shall require a new or amended permit.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

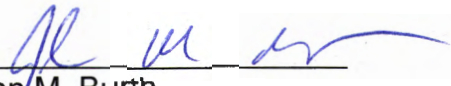
The Agency has considered all statutory and regulatory criteria for project approval set forth in the Adirondack Park Agency Act, the Freshwater Wetlands Act and 9 NYCRR Part 578, and 9 NYCRR Part 574. The Agency hereby finds that the subdivision authorized as conditioned herein:

- a. will be consistent with the land use and development plan;
- b. will be compatible with the character description and purposes, policies, and objectives of the Hamlet land use area;
- c. will be consistent with the overall intensity guidelines for the Hamlet land use area;
- d. will comply with the shoreline restrictions of § 806 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act;
- e. will not have an undue adverse impact upon the natural, scenic, aesthetic, ecological, wildlife, historic, recreational or open space resources of the Park or upon the ability of the public to provide supporting facilities and services made necessary by the project;
- f. will secure the natural benefits of wetlands associated with the project, consistent with the general welfare and beneficial economic, social, and agricultural development of the state; and
- g. will be compatible with preservation of the entire wetland and will not result in degradation or loss of any part of the wetland or its associated values.

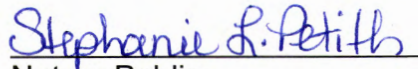

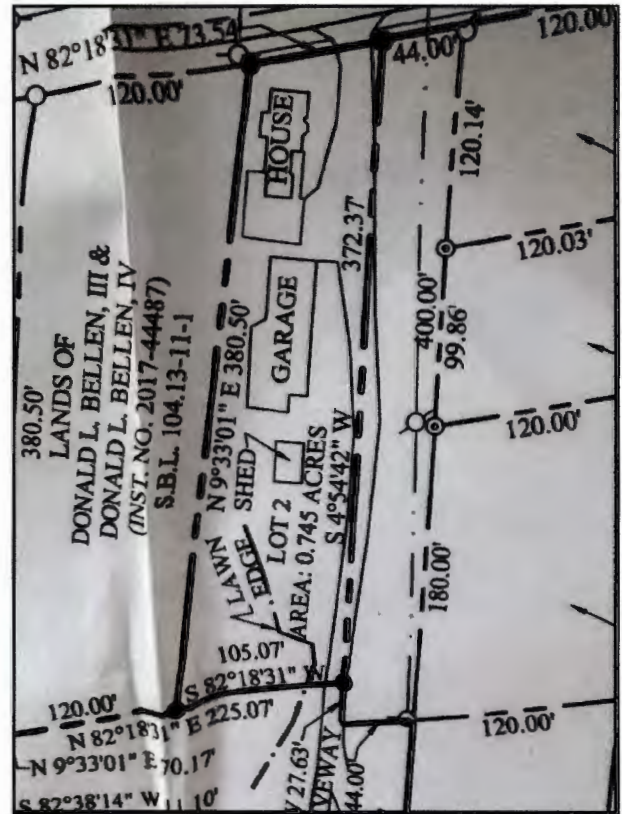
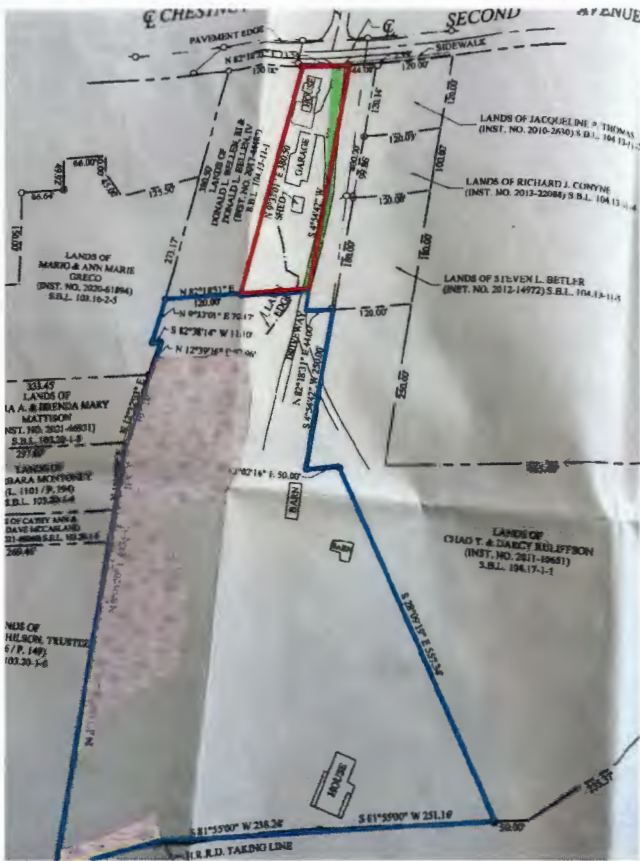
