Emergency Certification

The proposal described below constitutes an emergency project pursuant to § 572.15(c) of the Adirondack Park Agency Rules and Regulations and is being undertaken to protect life and/or property. Accordingly, no permit or further review of the proposal is required from the Adirondack Park Agency. This Emergency Certificate is based on and made only for the project described in the documents submitted in the August 14, 2026 correspondence from The LA Group to the Agency.

No otherwise jurisdictional activity shall occur on the project site without prior Agency approval beyond the emergency project described herein. Once there is no longer an immediate threat to life or property, the Applicant shall seek authorization from the Agency for any additional planned repairs, remediation or recovery from the emergency.

Emergency Project Description

The emergency project involves the replacement of a failed 3-foot diameter culvert with an improved 60-foot by 4-foot HDPE culvert, so that New Vermont Road can be accessed by safety personnel.

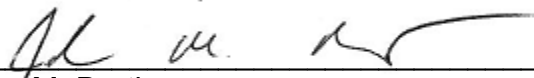
General Notice
