2. <u>Herbicide Treatment of Invasive Milfoil in the Adirondacks: Assessing Outcomes and Success Metrics</u> (Aaron Ziemann, APA)

For information: Agency staff will provide an overview of post-treatment reports associated with eight Agency-permitted herbicide treatments to control Eurasian watermilfoil, undertaken in 2024. The overview will include: an assessment of pre and post-treatment plant survey data, residual herbicide concentration monitoring, and applicator observations during the treatment process. Staff will also provide an evaluation of each applicant's stated treatment goals, and whether the treatments were successful by those metrics. The presentation will end with a discussion of each applicant's anticipated next steps in ongoing management efforts.

3. Getting My Feet Wet: An Internship Mapping Wetlands with the Adirondack Park Agency (Lydia Harvey, 2024 APA Intern)

For information: As part of her master's project, Lydia Harvey will present her research focusing on mapping deep water marshes in six lakes in the Park during the summer of 2024. Using GIS technology, boat-based surveys, and field data collection, the project focused on the distribution of these critical plant communities. The work provides essential data for the Agency to guide land use planning, monitor ecological changes, and enhance wetland conservation efforts.
